Visit a unique chapel founded in 1860 by Reverend English, a Methodist Circuit rider for the local community. Watch the various activities on the Davidson such as fly fishing, tubing and people enjoying the cool waters. Visit, and even join in an old style "swimming hole". Second 10km loop adds a Nature Trail, a portion of the North Slope Trail and the Pisgah Visitor Center. Only one credit even if completing all options.
