Description	Daily, 9-5. Admission required for entrance to house and gardens. Stroll through gardens, newly renovated conservatory and along paths and trails throughout the Estate not normally seen by visitors. Water and camera are musts. Trail shoes or hiking boots are recommended for the walk, and a walking stick would help. Carry a snack. For an additional 2 km, walk through 250 room chateau built by George Vanderbilt at the end of the 19th Century. No pets allowed in the house. A short video and 3D Diorama of the Estate grounds available at the registration area.

Start Point / Driving Directions	800-624-1575. From I-40, take exit 50 toward Asheville (north). Go three blocks (follow signs to Biltmore Estate), bear left and then turn left into Estate. Go through gatehouse and follow signs to Reception & Ticketing Center. Ask for "Walk Box" at Ticket Counter. Register, stamp books (difficult to return after walk) and drive to Start Point. Drive to parking area for visiting the house. Walk or take shuttle to START POINT which is in front of the house.
